Membership Criteria

- 3.5 G.P.A. (Scholarship)
- Meet service, character, and leadership expectations
- Pass full staff review
- Maintain NHS standards

National Honor Society membership requires a student to be outstanding in four areas. You have demonstrated outstanding **scholarship** based on your GPA and will now be evaluated in the areas of **leadership, service, and character**. This will be accomplished in two ways: a faculty council will review your information packet and your essay to determine ways in which you have shown service and leadership, and the full high school staff will evaluate you in the areas of character and leadership prior to making their recommendations.

Please review the following ways you can demonstrate your qualifications in the areas of leadership, service, and character.

Leadership

- Successfully hold school offices or positions of responsibility
- Promote school activities
- Contribute ideas that improve the civic life of the school
- Delegate responsibilities
- Model positive attitudes
- Actively participate in classes
- Influence peers in promoting school activities
- Be thoroughly dependable in homework
- Take initiative to work responsibly and reliably
- Demonstrate leadership in the classroom, at work, and in school or community activities
- Inspire positive behavior in others

Service

- Participate in some outside activity: Girl/Boy Scouts, 4-H, church groups, volunteer services for the aged, poor, or disadvantaged
- Work well with others and be willing to take on difficult or inconspicuous tasks
- Represent the school in scholastic competitions, sports, band, choir, etc.
- Volunteer with dependable and well-organized assistance, being gladly available and willing to sacrifice to offer assistance
- Cheerfully and enthusiastically perform any requested service to the school

Character

- Take criticism well and accept recommendations graciously
- Exemplify desirable qualities of behavior (cheerfulness, friendliness, poise, and stability)

- Demonstrate high standards of honesty and reliability
- Show courtesy, concern, and respect for others
- Help rid the school of bad influences or environments
